California Education Code, Section 49423 defines requirements for administration of medication "... any pupil who is required to take, during the regular school day, medication prescribed for him/her by a physician, may be assisted by the school nurse or other designated school personnel if the school district receives (1) <u>a written statement from such physician detailing the method</u>, amount, and time schedules by which medication is to be taken, and (2) a written statement from the parent or guardian of the pupil indicating the desire that the school district assist the pupil in the matter set forth in the physician's statement."

PARENT REQUEST AND AUTHORIZATION:

I request that the school nurse or designated school personnel assist my child with medication as ordered by the health care provider. I understand I may submit a written statement to withdraw my consent for administration of medication at school at any time.

I understand that the school must receive the medication in a container with a pharmacy label that indicates name of student, health care provider's name, medication, dose, route, and time to administer (over-the-counter medication must be in the original container). I understand that the medication must be delivered to the school by the parent, guardian, or adult designee.

I understand that medication (including over-the-counter) can only be administered to my child at school if the school has received <u>ALL</u> of the following: a.) Current California-authorized health care provider order, b.) Parent / guardian signature, and c.) Properly labeled medication.
